UPDATES

Governor Mike Kehoe was sworn in on Monday, January 13, 2025. His State of the State address is scheduled for January 29, 2025. On Tuesday, the <u>Governor named Sarah Willson as Director of DHSS</u> effective February 14, 2025. She awaits Missouri Senate Confirmation.

Director <u>Paula Nickelson will retire</u> March 1, 2025 after serving for 25 years in various positions at DHSS, including health care management, emergency planning and response, chronic disease prevention, and maternal-child health. Her recent achievements as Director included completing the COVID pandemic response, reestablishing the State Board of Health and Senior Services, achieving PHAB reaccreditation, hiring new positions to advance the future of public health, and working to rebuild trust.
