CDC Technical Assistance (TA)	Free TA services for Component B partners such as PHAB, NNPHI, and ASTHO	Administered by CDC for Component B grantees	Free of charge, CDC's TA agreement pays the TA organization directly	Contact CLPHS to request TA through the CDC's PHIVE system	This free resource should be used before moving to Missouri-specific supports below
LPHA Accreditation Technical Assistance	Expanding the MOCPE accreditation community of practice and delivering custom TA for LPHAs pursuing accreditation	Contract administered by DHSS, funded by PHIG until 2027	Yearly contract budget of \$254,140	LPHAs may contact MOCPE directly to request support or join a communication	LPHAs may participate in group TA opportunities or request hands-on assistance as needed
PHAB Readiness Assessment	DHSS is contracting directly with PHAB to allow access to the Accreditation Readiness Assessment and training resources for all LPHAs	Contract administered by DHSS, funded by PHIG until 2027	Assessments are \$1299 each, A total of \$149,385 is available to cover costs for all 115 LPHAs	Contact CLPHS to connect with PHAB	The PHAB Readiness Assessment and training on the assessment are the only allowable uses of this funding
Direct Funding	Funding to support LPHAs for any allowable activities under the CDC PHIG guidance	Direct funding administered by CLPHS, funded by PHIG until 2027	\$27,566,658 awarded to be distributed across 114 LPHAs	Contact CLPHS to submit a funding request	Direct funding support is available for a wide range of activities, including accreditation
Cost Reimbursement for Accreditation	Funding to support LPHAs as they pursue accreditation. This includes hiring, paying staff time, contracting, and supply purchases.	Administered by CLPHS, funded by PHIG until 2027	Currently budgeted for \$2.5 million per year until 2027	Interested LPHAs may apply for funding and will contract with DHSS to distribute funding support for allowable uses	This funding source is limited to the yearly budget. We currently anticipate applying for this yearly through the grant period ending Nov 30, 2027.
LPHA Incentive Funding	Incentive payments designed to encourage and reward public health service delivery	Administered by CLPHS, funded by state general revenue	Funding amounts are based on the same percentage of the total each LPHA receives through core funding	After completed an incentive funding exercise, email IncentiveFundingSubmissions@health.mo.gov	Guidance and reporting requirements are available on the LPHA resource page
