- COVID-19, RSV, and Influenza orders can include pediatric and adult doses.
- Reconciliations must be current, or no older than 14 days, to submit an order.
- Orders may be adjusted to accommodate limited supply.
- Partially filled orders will need to be re-ordered by the provider later.
- See re-ordering details available via the VFC Program Comments in your approved or rejected order.
- **Novavax** Providers will be notified via email and posted in the ShowMeVax news when the Novavax vaccine is available for order.
- **317 Adult Vaccines** COVID-19 and RSV vaccines will **not** be available to order until October 1, 2024.
